
# Specifications Elites 2024



### Welcome

Dear Elites,

You have registered for the Mont Blanc Marathon as an Elite runner and this entails certain obligations. We invite you to take note of the information opposite concerning your participation.

The Chamonix Mont-Blanc Sports Club, an association under the law of 1901, is organising the Mont-Blanc Marathon races from 27 to 30 June 2024.

#### Informations



Elite runners may be invited to various events (official presentation, press conference, etc.). If you receive such an invitation from the organisers, you MUST attend.



Team Managers must be accredited **before 24 June** and collect their accreditation from the Chamonix Sports Club. Accreditation gives them access to the 'Team Zone' at the refreshment posts and at the finish (closed to the public). Accreditation link **Accreditations Team Manager** 

Accreditation does not give you free access to the ski lifts. You will need a lift pass if you wish to use them.



Team managers are authorised to refuel their riders **20 metres before or 20 metres after the refreshment points**, depending on the refreshment point. Access to the refreshment tent is forbidden for the Team Managers. Outside these zones, refuelling is forbidden and may result in time penalties for the riders.

Compulsory equipment is required on the Mont Blanc Marathon races to ensure runners' safety. There will be frequent checks to ensure that runners



have this equipment.

As an elite runner, you are surrounded by a great deal of media attention, so you must be exemplary in this respect.



- Photo ID.
- At least one litre of water.
- Waterproof jacket with hood (Gore-Tex type), suitable for your size.
- A warm second layer (with long sleeves) suited to your size.
- A headlamp or chest lamp with spare batteries.
- Survival blanket (140cm x 200cm).
- Whistle.
- Tumbler.
- Bowl and spoon.

### Withdrawal of race bibs

Race bibs will only be issued to runners **in person and on presentation of an ID card with photo.** Each runner must bring a race bag containing all the compulsory equipment for the race in which he or she is taking part so that a timing chip can be fitted.

The race number will not be given to a runner who does not present the compulsory equipment for the race in which he or she is registered.



Race bibs can only be collected by appointment. Appointment slots must be booked before 16 June in <u>your runners'</u> <u>space.</u>







### Image rights



The Club des Sports de Chamonix is the organiser of a sporting event called the 'Marathon du Mont-Blanc' which will take place from 27 to 30 June 2024.

In application of the provisions of article L 333-1 of the French Sports Code, the Club des Sports de Chamonix is the exclusive owner of the right to exploit this event.

In this context, the Club des Sports de Chamonix is the sole owner of the image rights of each of the competitors taking part in the event, who have expressly waived this right at the time of registration.

Any communication about the event or use of images of the event must respect the name of the event, registered trademarks and with the official agreement of the organisers. Consequently, only the organisers have the right to use runners' images and may transfer this right.

Unless a licence is obtained from the Club des Sports de Chamonix, the capture and use of images is strictly forbidden.

This means that the use of any images of runners in a race is subject to a licence issued by the Club des Sports de Chamonix. **If you wish to purchase this licence please contact the Club des Sports de Chamonix by email at club@chamonixsport.com**

### Medical certificate

In France, the regulations introduced by the FFA (Fédération Française d'Athlétisme) require all runners taking part in competitions to produce a **medical** certificate stating that they are not contraindicated in running or athletics in competition and that it is less than one year old on the day of the race, or a 2023-2024 FFA licence.

To finalise your registration for one of the Mont Blanc Marathon races, you will need to submit your document by logging on to your online runners' area.

This document must be uploaded to your DOKEOP profile as soon as possible and no later than 21 June 2024!

#### Elites SAS

#### An Elite SAS will be set up on the Mont Blanc Marathon races. Access to this SAS will be determined according to the participants' UTMB index.

Your SAS number and race bib number are already available in your runner's space.

Please make sure you have your race number withdrawal card in order to collect your race number.

The organisation will only be setting up Elite SASs for the following races:

- 90 KM du Mont-Blanc
- 42 KM du Mont-Blanc
- 23 KM of Mont-Blanc

### Disqualification Penalty

Each runner taking part in the Mont Blanc Marathon races undertakes to respect the rules to ensure a fair race. It is vital that you respect these commitments, otherwise you may be penalised.

As an Elite runner, you will be surrounded by a great deal of media attention, so **you must be exemplary in this respect.** 

The race marshals present on the course and the officials in charge of the various checkpoints and refreshment posts are empowered to ensure that the rules are respected and to apply an immediate (\*) penalty.

You will find opposite the **table of penalties applicable** during the Mont Blanc Marathon races in the event of failure to comply with the rules and in particular in the event of the absence of compulsory equipment.

RULES BREACH	TYPE OF PENALTY
Absence of compulsory safety equipment and/or if more than 3 items are missing	Time penalty or Disqualification
Refusal to check compulsory equipment	Disqualification
Throwing of litter (deliberate) by a runner or a member of his entourage	Disqualification
No respect for people (organisation or runners)	Lifetime disqualification
Failure to assist a person in difficulty	Disqualification
Assistance outside authorised areas	Time penalty
Cheating (e.g. exchanging race numbers, using means of transport, etc.)	Lifetime disqualification
No visible bib	Time penalty
Refusal to obey an order from race management, a race steward, a station chief, a doctor or a first- aider	Disqualification
Failure to follow the signposted route	Time penalty

(\*) Any other breach of the rules will be penalised as decided by the Race Jury.


## Prize-giving ceremony
